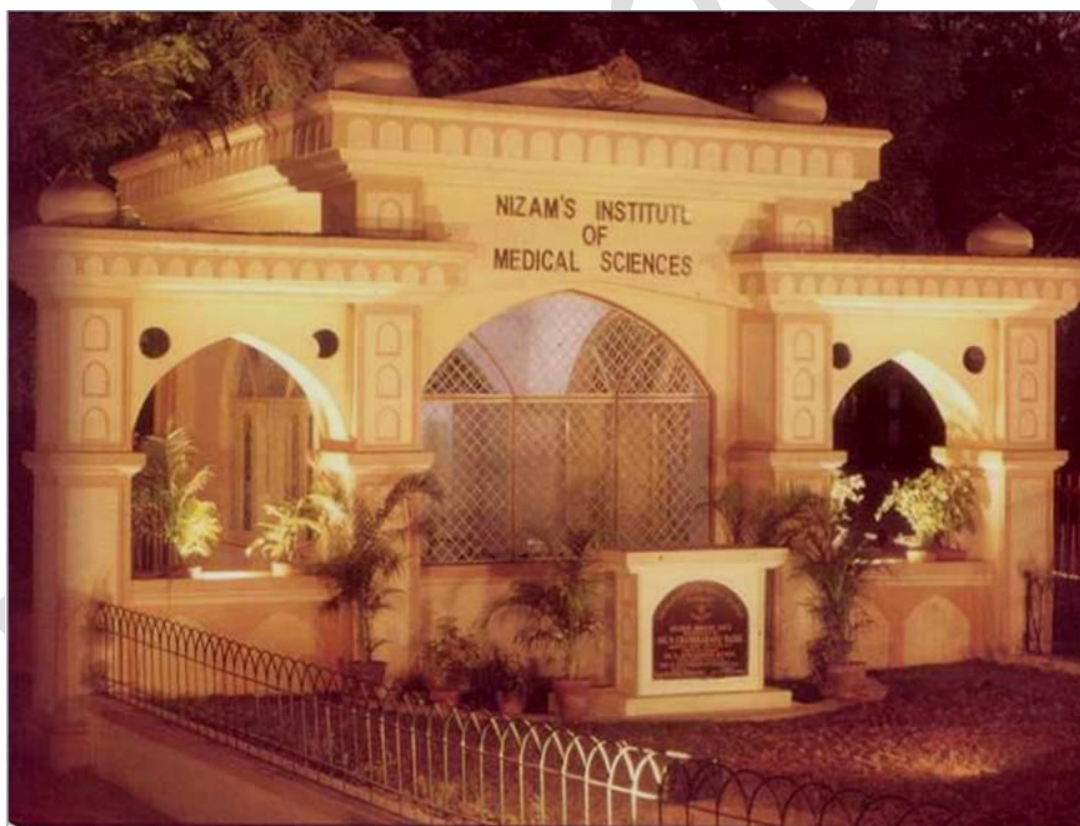

I. Notification

Applications are invited from eligible candidates of Telangana State for admission into B.Sc.(Nursing) course for the year 2020.

II. Number of seats, duration of course and entry qualification required:

Subject	Seats	Duration-years	Entry Qualification
B.Sc (Nursing) (for women only)	100	4 years	<p>A pass in Intermediate (10+2) course with Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry and English or Vocational Nursing (2 years Vocational course under Para-medical category-V, Multi Purpose Health Worker-F) with Bridge course of Biological and Physical Sciences or equivalent. Should have secured not less than 45% of marks on the average in the subjects of Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry and English.</p> <p>Students shall be medically fit.</p>

Note: Those who belong to SC,ST and BC categories are eligible with 40% aggregate marks in the Science Group subjects (Botany, Physics, Chemistry and Zoology)

* 5 Seats are reserved for regular in-service candidates working in NIMS.

III. AGE

The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years completed on or before 31st December, 2020 and should not be more than 25 years as on 31st December, 2020. Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years in the case of SC & ST Candidates.

IV. Statutory Reservations for SCs, STs, & BCs

- a) Rule of reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward class candidates i.e. 15%, 6% and 29% (BC-A 7%, BC-B 10%, BC-C 1%, BC-D 7%, BC-E 4%) respectively will be followed by taking the total number of seats.
- b) Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate issued by the competent authority of Government of Telangana as per the format prescribed at Annexure V.
- c) There shall be 5% reservation for differently-abled (Physically Handicapped-PH) with locomotor disability of 50% to 70% confined to lower limbs. The candidates shall be selected on horizontal basis among general and reserved categories. In case of

temporarily disabled persons, the PH certificate should be issued within 3 months prior to presenting her application for seeking admission by claiming the benefit of reservation, by the Medical Board Vide G.O.Ms.No.109 Women's Development Child Welfare and Labour Department dated 15-06-1992. The Medical Board constituted by the NIMS will examine these candidates and scrutinize their claim for reservation under PH for confirmation of eligibility.

- d) BC-E reservation: There shall be 4% reservation under BC-E as per memo No.19392/A2/2007 dated 29-11-2007. The BC-E certificate based on G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2), dated 7th July, 2007 should be obtained from Mandal Revenue Officer/Tahsildar on or after 7th July, 2007. Admission under BC-E category is subject to condition of further orders issued either by the Government of Telangana or Hon'ble High Court for the State of Telangana/Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

NOTE:

- i. The seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes shall be made available to Scheduled Castes and Vice-versa, if qualified candidates are not available in the category. If qualified candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Communities are not available the left over seats reserved for them shall be treated as un-reserved seats and shall be filled by the qualified candidates of General Pool.
- ii. If qualified candidates belonging to backward class of a particular group are not available, the leftover seats shall be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to backward classes are not available to fill up the seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as unreserved and shall be filled up with qualified candidates of General pool.
- iii. If qualified candidates belonging to differently abled (physically handicapped) are not available, the leftover seat/seats shall be treated as unreserved and shall be filled up with qualified candidates of General pool.

V. Local Area Reservations

Admissions to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates of Telangana State in relation to local area as provided in Telangana Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 and subsequent amendments

The Non local candidates are eligible for 15% unreserved seats only. The local candidates of Telangana State are also eligible for 15% unreserved seats along with 85% seats reserved for local area.

VI. Local Area

The part of the State comprising the districts of Adilabad, Bhadradi Kothagudem, Hyderabad, Jagtial, Jangaon, Jayashankar Bhaupalapally, Jogulamba Gadwal, Kamareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Kumarambheem Asifabad, Mahabubabad, Mahabubnagar, Mancheri, Medak, Medchal- Malkajiri, Nagarkurnool, Nalgonda, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Peddapalli, Rajanna Sircilla, Ranga Reddy, Sangareddy, Siddipet, Suryapet, Vikarabad, Wanaparthy, Warangal Rural, Warangal Urban and Yadadri Bhuvanagiri shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission.

VII. Local Candidates

A candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area

- i. If she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.
- ii. The applicant who claims to be local candidate shall produce study certificate/ certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4/7 consecutive years as the case may be ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

VIII. Application Procedure:

1. The Online Application Registration, Notification and instructions to fill the application is available at NIMS website : www.nims.edu.in. from 11.00 AM on 12/10/2020 till 5.00 PM of 23/10/2020 and last date for submission of hard copy of online application is 27/10/2020.
2. **NOTE:** The candidates are advised to take a print out of the **prospectus/ instructions** to fill the application form from the NIMS website: www.nims.edu.in before proceeding to fill the online application form.
3. Incomplete and hand-written application forms are liable to be rejected.
4. **An amount of Rs. 700/- (Rupees seven hundred only) towards application fee should be remitted through payment gateway provided using a Credit Card or a Debit Card issued by the banks in India or through Internet banking.** Application fee is not refundable even if the application is summarily rejected.
5. **The hard copy of the online application duly signed shall be submitted to The Associate Dean, Academic-2, 2nd floor, Old OPD Block, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad 500 082 on or before 5.00 PM of 27-10-2020 along with all the documents mentioned in the annexure-I**

6. The applications received after the prescribed date and time shall not be considered. The Institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of application or delay in postal transit.
7. An acknowledgement will be sent to the respective candidate by sms / e-mail or to the login account after the Application is processed.
8. The applications of in-service candidates should be forwarded by the appointing authority. The in-service candidates are required to submit Service Certificate and No Objection Certificate in original from the Appointing Authority at the time of submission of application.
9. The in-service candidates should have a minimum of five years regular service. Applications should be forwarded by the Head of the Institution.
10. All candidates who are employees in the State of Telangana and Central Government under takings, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public Institutions should submit their hard copy of the applications along with No Objection Certificate from the appointing authority. The selected candidates should submit relieving order along with original certificates at the time of admission.

IX. Method of Selection:

1. Selection will be made based on the merit arrived out of total marks obtained in the qualifying examination i.e., Intermediate (Bi.P.C.) or equivalent.
2. Candidates shall be ranked in the order of merit based on the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination. In case of tie, marks obtained in Zoology, in case of further tie, marks obtained in Botany, further tie, marks obtained in Chemistry, further tie, marks obtained in Physics in the qualifying examination shall be taken into consideration.
3. The merit list of the eligible candidates will be displayed at NIMS website: www.nims.edu.in on the dates notified in prospectus. No individual correspondence will be made in this regard.
4. Counselling letters may be downloaded by the candidate through login account on the notified date
5. The candidates called for the counselling shall come prepared to overstay for one more day beyond the date of counselling in case it is required.
6. The counselling shall be conducted at the venue, date and time specified by the Institute.
7. The selection shall be based on the merit in the Intermediate (Bi.P.C.) or equivalent. The statutory reservation rules and GOP No. 646 dated 10th July, 1979 for local/Non-local area reservations will be followed during counselling. Candidates have to report for counselling on the date and time specified in person with a counselling fee of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) and should sign in the attendance register within the stipulated time failing which she shall not be permitted to attend counselling and forfeits the right to admission and the seat shall be offered to the next candidate in the merit list. No request

for postponing the date of counselling or request to appear at an earlier date shall be entertained. The candidates recommended for provisional admission are required to pay an amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) towards counselling fee immediately. This amount will be adjusted against the course fee to be paid along with the balance of fee to be collected. The counselling fee will be refunded to candidates who are medically unfit at the time of Admission after deducting the medical examination fee of Rs.3,500/- In case the candidate does not, for any reason, report for admission within the specified period, the counselling fee will be forfeited.

8. The candidates belongs to SC/ST whose parents/guardian income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) per annum are not required to pay non-refundable (tuition) fee at the time of admission. However, the candidate is required to submit an undertaking/bond (non-judicial stamped paper of Rs.100/-) along with two sureties (Parents/Guardian) as per format prescribed at Annexure IV that they shall pay the prescribed fee for their respective courses before completion of each year (I/II/III and IV years), if they fails to get sanction of scholarship from the respective government departments. The fee towards other heads amounting to Rs.5,800/- (Rupees five thousand and eight hundred only) except tuition fee shall be paid at the time of counselling. It is mandatory to submit "either of Parents/ Guardian" income certificate in original for academic year 2020 issued by not below the rank of Tahsildar/Mandal Revenue Officer at the time of counselling **failing which the candidate is required to pay the fee as prescribed at para 7.**
9. For in-service candidates who are pursuing studies and who cannot deposit the original certificates at the time of counselling have to bring Xerox copies of the original certificates duly attested by the controlling authorities of the institution. They shall also produce a certificate from the institution that they have no objection to the candidate's admission to the B.Sc. (Nursing) course and in the event of selection of the candidate to the course she shall be relieved immediately. Failure to submit the original certificates shall render the candidate ineligible for admission.

X. Admission:

1. All those candidates who are selected for admission have to submit the original certificates on the date of admission and undergo medical examination. After medical fitness is cleared, the remaining annual fee has to be paid by the candidate. Failure to submit the required certificates or payment of fee shall render the candidate forfeit the seat and such seat shall be allotted to the next candidate in the merit list.

b) Total fee to be paid during the subsequent years at the beginning of classes i.e. 2nd year, 3rd year and 4th year is Rs.36,050/- each year.

- i. The fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
- ii. All the in-service candidates, who are selected for admission, are also required to pay the above fee.

2. The selection of each student will be subject to medical fitness. The medical fitness will be decided by the Medical Board appointed by the Institute. The decision of the Medical Board shall be final. If found medically unfit, counselling fee will be refunded after deducting the medical examination fee of Rs.3,500/-.
3. In all matters relating to selections and admissions, the decision of the Institute shall be final and binding on the candidates and selection cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.
4. All the candidates joining the course shall execute a bond in the prescribed form on a non-judicial stamped paper of Rs.100/- value along with two sureties (Parents/Guardian) to ensure completion of the prescribed period of course or in default to pay the bond amount and shall also have to refund the amount if any received as stipend up to that date to NIMS. The format of the bond to be executed may be seen in Annexure II. The candidates who resign the course under this clause shall not be considered for any other course on the basis of merit during the same academic year. The course imparted prior to resignation shall not be counted for any other purposes. In the case of in-service candidates they have to execute a bond to satisfy the study leave rules of NIMS.
5. The original certificates submitted by the candidates shall not be returned to the candidates till they complete their course of study and appear for the final examination or on fulfilling condition (4) above.
6. No individual correspondence will be made with regard to status of application, selection/ counselling/admission and any other updates. Candidates are requested to follow the instructions/information stated in prospectus and at website: www.nims.edu.in as per the scheduled programme mentioned in prospectus. The candidates are required to visit website regularly.

XI. After Admission

1. The student shall maintain strict discipline during the period of study/training programme in terms of conduct rules of the NIMS. Violation of the conduct rules will result in the cancellation of the admission of the candidate apart from invoking the terms and conditions of the bond. The candidate shall not resort to any strikes during period of their study in dereliction of their duties or air their views criticizing the policies of the institute either before the print or electronic media or anywhere.
2. All students shall adhere to the institutional rules and violation of rules will be viewed seriously.
3. The selected candidates shall join the course by the date prescribed. In case the selected candidate does not report by the date, the next candidate in the order of merit will be selected in her place. No extension of time will be entertained.

4. The admission stands closed by the date announced and the course shall commence from the notified date. Due to unforeseen reasons if a seat falls vacant within the period of closure of admissions, the candidate next in order of merit as per rules will be considered for admission.
5. Institute reserves the right to change the schedule after due notification.
6. The candidate shall not register for any other Degree / Diploma and continue the studies, unless specifically permitted by the Institute.
7. All selected candidates must maintain a logbook recording their day to day academic activities, which are to be submitted to the Dean, through proper channel once in six months.
8. The institute shall fix duties and responsibilities of students from time to time. They will be required to pursue such works as may be needed in the legitimate interest of patient care in the hospital.
9. The course is a full time course. The candidate shall be a full time student. No student is allowed to do any private practice or consultation. "all the candidates joining the course shall work as 'full time students' during the period of training and shall attend not less than 80% (eighty percent) of the imparted training during each academic year including assignments, assessed full time responsibilities and participation in all facets of the educational process.
10. Candidates found to be ineligible at any stage of the course will not be permitted to appear in the final examination. In an unlikely event of any ineligible candidate appearing and/or being successful in the examination, the results of such a candidate shall be cancelled and/or deemed to be cancelled.
11. Resultant vacancies shall be filled by the candidates belonging to the same category as those who vacated the corresponding seat.
12. Institute is not responsible for any unforeseen events preventing the candidate from reaching for counselling and the candidate will be considered absent under such circumstances.
13. Any attempt on the part of the candidate to influence directly or indirectly by any means will be treated as disqualification.

XII. Break of study and Re-admission

The rules prescribed by the Institute shall be applicable from time to time.

XIII. Closure of admission

The admissions stand closed by the prescribed date and the courses shall commence from the notified date. The duration of the course shall be calculated from the date of commencement of the course without any reference to the date of joining of any

individual. Due to unforeseen reasons if a seat falls vacant within the period of closure of admissions as per INC rules, the candidate next in order of merit as per rules will be considered for admission.

XIV. Uniform

Student Nurses shall wear white uniform while on duty as prescribed by the Institute.

XV. Stipend

1. The selected candidates will be paid stipend as per the following rates (the rates of stipend shall however be as prescribed by the Government of Telangana from time to time):

1st year Rs.1,500/- per month
 2nd year Rs.1,700/- per month
 3rd year Rs.1,900/- per month
 4th year Rs.2,200/- per month

2. The in-service candidates are not entitled for stipend.
3. The candidates must complete the final examination within a period of 8 years from the date of admission to the course, failing which the candidate will be required to re-register for course after getting herself selected for the course.

XVI. Boarding & Lodging

No boarding and lodging shall be provided by the Institute for this year/batch.

XVII. Vacation and Leave

- a. All students are eligible for 6 - 8 weeks of vacation including preparatory holidays and they are also eligible for public holidays. The candidates are eligible for sick leave for 14 days as recommended by the Medical Officer of the Institute.
- b. The students shall undergo extra training for the period covered by the absence and continue the training until the next examination.
- c. The students can avail maternity leave up to 180 days only once in their course of study and the study period will be extended to the extent of Maternity Leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the Institute examination till the completion of study period as per INC Regulations (Duration of Course). Payment of stipend shall be limited to 48 months from the date of joining (subject to attendance) and no stipend is payable for the extended period of training.
- d. If a student is absent for more than 30 days without sanction of leave, she shall be treated as deemed to have discontinued and the bond amount shall be recovered.

XVIII. Discontinuation of the course

Students are permitted to discontinue the course under the following condition without any penalty.

- i) Illness certified by the Medical Board of the institute.

XIX. Examinations:

- i) The students will have to appear for such examinations as are prescribed by the institute from time to time.
- ii) The student to appear for final year examination is required to clear all the previous examinations.
- iii) No student shall be allowed to appear for examinations unless she has paid the examination fee and other fee due payable to the Institute.

XX. Termination of training and dismissal

A candidate admitted to the course shall be liable for dismissal at any time before the completion of the course on account of negligence, failure to complete the prescribed studies and duties, insubordination, misconduct or any other offences amounting to moral turpitude on the part of the candidate which in the opinion of the Head of the institute makes it undesirable to continue the candidate in the institute.

XXI. Powers of Dean:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Dean NIMS may at any time before completion of the course either on his own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks' time from the date of receipt of the show cause notice to submit a written explanation and on personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the course, if in his opinion such candidate had furnished incorrect particulars / false information in the application or in the documents attached thereto or in the statement made either before the authority in-charge of admission or the Dean or any other manner. Against any such order of the Dean, the appeal shall lie with the Director, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.

XXII. These rules are subject to change in accordance with the decisions of the Institute taken from time to time.

Note: Anti Ragging Act - Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions as per Andhra Pradesh Prohibition of Ragging Act No.26 of 1997, dated 21-08-1997 or any guidelines issued by either Government of Telangana State or Government of India and any amendments made from time to time.

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the Institution.
